## Campus Ministry

I am thankful to God for the opportunity to return to all the campus clubs this year. Our volunteers have maintained the good work that the Lord has started in my absence. It is comforting to see the ministry of the Holy Spirit continuing through these faithful vessels. Since being back, I have noticed a willingness from the students to learn about God, Jesus, Holy Spirit, and His love for us. In several meetings the students have been attentive and engaging through questions/comments.

We have begun this year sharing the importance of God in three persons. Through the Bible, students are learning how God exists as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit and how He manifests Himself to us through the Trinity. In our time and conversations, we discussed how God created the heavens, the earth, and how He created us in His image. We asked an obvious question, where were you when God created all this? We asked, how do we know He is the Creator? God's love for us revealed it. He wants to include us in all He does, so He shared it through Moses.

We read the verse, *“Let us make man in our image...”* (Gen. 1:26) We asked if God is talking, who is “us”? who is “our”? in this passage. That opened the door to some good responses, which lead students responding “God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit.” Then we asked what does it mean to be made in God's image? Again, this led to more

discussions. We shared how humans have been given the ability by God to love (e.g. parents and children) or the ability to have faith (e.g. medicine for headache). These are a few ways mankind is made in His image. Only in relationship with God, is ability to love and operate in faith complete. That is God the Father's original intention for us, and He has restored this relationship through faith in our Lord Jesus.

At La Familia, one student shared the love he experienced when he gave his life to Jesus and was baptized. How God's love had overwhelmed him for the next few months. Unknown to me at that time, he was struggling before Bible club. Our advisor shared that after the meeting. The Holy Spirit reminded him that day and encourage him in his walk. *“But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom My Father will send in My name. He will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all the things I said to you”* (John 14:26). What a wonderful adventure in Jesus! What a privilege to watch His love touch a life. Our beautiful, wonderful Savior! To Him be the glory and honor!
